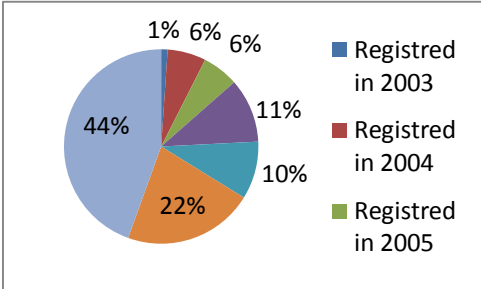

We have students living in Yakima, Union Gap, Wapato, Moxee, Mabton and Tieton. 255 (91%) of the students lives in yakima and from it 48 % in the 90901 area and 37% in the 98902. They are from El Salvador, Colombia, Mexico, Dominican Republic and Honduras. 34% of them are from Michoacan Mexico and 16% from Jalisco

The average age for our adult students is 36 years old, been our oldest 77 and the youngest is 20 years old.
