## **BASIC EDUCATION**

### **English as a Second Language (ESL) Levels 1-5**

This course teaches beginning and intermediate English skills; speaking, listening, writing, and reading. Students are actively involved in choosing content areas and receive individual attention to assure progress.

#### ***Monday, Wednesday, & Friday***

### **Literacy**

This class is offered to Hispanic women who are in need of learning how to read and write in their native language.
